Trails:

Franklin – 6/12 KM rated 2B. Walk through
picturesque town established in 1700's by the
Scotch/Irish. See churches, cemeteries and
Indian mound. While strolling quaint downtown,
visit the Scottish Tartan Historic Society
Museum and the Gem Museum. Gem Museum
has the largest collection of gems in the SE.
Walk the quiet Little Tennessee Greenway
including a covered bridge. No special
programs. Macon County for Tarheel 100
Program.

Tallulah – 5/11 KM rated 1B. Enjoy walking
the rim of the deepest gorge east of the
Mississippi with great views of gorge and falls
from overlooks on both rims. Interpretive Center
has interesting movie and exhibits. As option,
you can go down 300 stairs to suspension
bridge and 347 steps up to other rim making
trail rating 4. 11 KM includes loop of wooded
trails along old Short Line (made famous by
Monopoly) rail bed and lake formed by Tallulah
Dam. No special programs. \$3 parking fee
(exact change).

Trails (continued):

Cherokee – 6/10/12/24 KM rated 2B.

Depending on route(s) used, you will enjoy walking along a swift flowing river, Museum of the Cherokee, Qualla Arts and Crafts Center, the site of Pageant - Onto These Hills, Oconaluftee Indian Village and Gardens, Oconaluftee Island Park with its bamboo tunnel, Oconaluftee Visitor Center (gateway to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park) with its mountain farm museum. All can be experienced on the 24 KM route. Special programs - National Parks and Ice Cream Parlors. Swain County for Tarheel 100.

Highlands – 5/10 KM rated 3C. Climb up to Sunset Rock for magnificent view of Highlands (fascinating old resort town) and surrounding mountains where southerners came to escape the summer heat. Meander through Botanical Gardens with lake and boardwalk. Continue on Highlands Plateau Greenway into town where you can enjoy shopping and eating in upscale shops and restaurants. Special programs - Ice Cream Parlors, City Parks and Little Library. Macon County for Tarheel 100

Trail Notes: Restrooms at or near start points. Sneakers OK for all short distance walks and all of Franklin and Cherokee. Sturdy shoes for the rest. Pets OKs. Always carry water and a snack.

Fees and Awards: IVV credit is \$3. IVV credit for children 15 and under is free. Free walkers welcome. **DONATIONS WELCOME.**

Procedure: All participants must complete a Start Card at Registration Point. Card is carried on walk and returned when done. This applies even if you are a free walker. An adult must accompany all children under 16. All Start Cards remain the property of the Asheville Amblers.

Stipulations: Event proceeds rain or shine. NO REFUNDS.

Where to stay: Rooms reserved at Comfort Inn Franklin. Ask for “Asheville Ambler” special rate \$114. Call 828-369-9200.

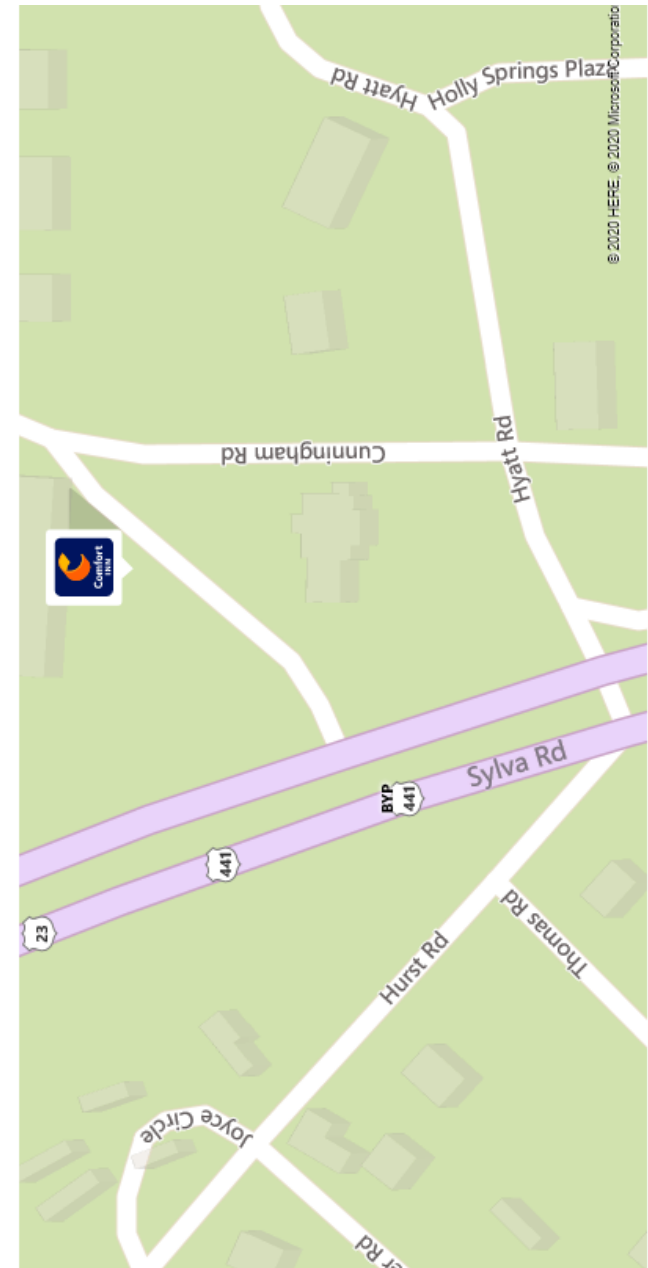
What is a Volkswalk: A non-competitive walk, typically 10KM (6.2 miles) long through an historic or scenic area. It is designed to promote fun, fitness and fellowship. American GIs brought it from Germany in the 1960s.

Directions: [Southbound to Franklin on US 441 to Hyatt Rd \(light\). Left on Hyatt .6 mile to Cunningham \(KFC on corner\). Left on Cunningham .8 mile to Comfort Inn on left. Northbound to Franklin, right on Hyatt to Cunningham as above.](#)
