STIPULATIONS: The fee for all walkers whether for AVA/IVV credit stamp or not is \$3. No refunds are provided after the start of the walk. The event takes place under all weather conditions unless deemed unsafe due to lightning or named storms requiring evacuation.

PROCEDURE: Arrive for the walk at 9:30 am with the walk to begin at 10:00 am. The walk returns to the start and the completion time is 1 to 3 hours.

PARTICIPATION: This is a fun event for all persons. People of all ages are welcome to participate though an adult must sign for children under 18.

REGISTRATION: Register at the start and begin the walk.

FOOD and WATER: Water is not available at the Start. In Florida it is suggested that you carry your own drinking water.

SANCTIONED: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

Crady Fishing Bridge, FL Walk

DATE: February 24, 2018, Sanction #110635
LOCATION: Amelia Island State Park, A1A, Fernandina Beach, FL 32226
START TIME: Register at 9:30 a.m., walk starts promptly at 10:00 a.m.
DISTANCES: 5, 7 and 12 km
TRAIL RATING: 1A
AVA Special Prog: Food for Thought, Points of Reference, Walking America's Ports of Call, Walking the USA, A-Z

DESCRIPTION: This walk crosses the Crady Fishing Bridge, then after crossing A1A proceeds across a long boardwalk onto a nature trail. Along the way you will encounter many species of shore birds as well as beautiful views of the South Amelia River, Nassau Sound and the Atlantic Ocean. You will visit Boneyard Beach with huge roots of shoreline trees that have toppled due to beach erosion.

Water and restrooms are available at the start point and along the route.

DIRECTIONS: From Heckscher Dr. (A1A) going north, cross the long bridge adjacent to the Crady Fishing Bridge. This is approx. 11 miles north of the Ferry on Heckscher Dr. The first right after the bridge is the entrance to Amelia Island State Park. From Fernandina Beach heading south, approx. 3 miles south of the Omni Amelia Island Plantation Resort take the left (just before crossing the bridge) into Amelia Island State Park. Go through the first parking lot and proceed to the second lot by the water. Look for people wearing red shirts.
