STIPULATIONS: The fee for all walkers is \$3. No refunds are provided after the start of the walk. The event takes place under all weather conditions unless deemed unsafe due to lightning or named storms requiring evacuation.

PROCEDURE: Arrive for the walk at 8:30 a.m. with the walk to begin at 9:00 a.m. The walk returns to the start and the completion time is 1 to 3 hours.

PARTICIPATION: This is a fun event for all persons. People of all ages are welcome to participate though an adult must sign for children under 18.

REGISTRATION: Register at the start and begin the walk.

FOOD and WATER: Water and restrooms are not available at the Start or along the route. In Florida it is suggested that you carry your own drinking water.

SANCTIONED: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

DISCLAIMER: The sponsors will expend every reasonable effort to make this event safe and enjoyable for all; however, The First Coast Trail Forgers and AVA are not liable for accidents, thefts, and/or material damage.

FEES: The fee for all walkers is \$3. Park Entrance Fee is \$6 per vehicle (2-8 people), \$4 single occupancy vehicle. There is an additional \$2.50 per person admission fee to the fort.

DESCRIPTION: Ft. Clinch is located at the mouth of the St. Mary's River in Fernandina Beach. The park is 1400 acres and contains 3 miles of shorelines. The fort itself was built in the 19th century. Our walk will follow nature trails through the park and a walk on the beach. A wide variety of wildlife lives throughout the park. If you desire, you can walk through the fort after the walk. Restrooms are available at the start point.



ADDITIONAL INFO: This is the 1st walk of a 2 walk day. The 2nd walk is our YRE Historic Downtown Fernandina starting at 1:30 with lunch in between.

DIRECTIONS: I95 exit 373 head E to SR 200/A1A to Fernandina Beach. At Centre St/Atlantic Ave, right to entrance to Ft. Clinch State Park on left. After passing the ranger's station, drive 3 miles to the parking lot located at the fort.
