Jacksonville University (Jacksonville, FL) Guided Walk

LOCATION: University Park Library Branch Parking Lot (facing University Blvd.), 3435 University Blvd. North
START TIME: Register at 8:30 a.m. Walk begins promptly at 9:00 a.m.
DISTANCES: 5 and 10 Km

DESCRIPTION: Jacksonville University is located in a beautiful setting along the banks of the St. Johns River. The 190 acre campus includes a half-mile of waterfront, oak-lined paths and a mix of historic and new buildings. The university was founded in 1934 and moved to its current location in the early 1950's. After leaving the university campus, the trail passes along neighborhood streets. This part of the trail is also partially shaded.

MAP AND DIRECTIONS TO START POINT: From I-95, take W. Union St/US 90 east to the exit for University Blvd/FL-109 North. Library is 2/5 miles ahead on right.
