DESCRIPTION: St. Johns is located in the Jacksonville metro area and lies approximately halfway between downtown Jacksonville and downtown St. Augustine. Julington Creek is considered the young Ponte Vedra because it's age demographics range from 30-50 and is 2nd only to neighboring Ponte Vedra in having the highest per capita wealth in NE Florida. Part of the walk takes us through some of the trails available in Mandarin Park.
