STIPULATIONS: The fee for all walkers is \$3. The event takes place under all weather conditions unless deemed unsafe due to lightning or named storms requiring evacuation. No refunds are provided after the start of the walk.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE: Arrive for the walk at 8:30 am with the walk to begin at 9:00 am. The walk returns to the start and the completion time is 1 to 3 hours.

PARTICIPATION: This is a fun event for all persons. People of all ages are welcome to participate though an adult must accompany children under 18.

Murray Hill, Jacksonville, FL Walk

LOCATION: Four Corners Park, 4602 Lawnview St., Jacksonville, FL 32205

START TIME: Register at 8:30 a.m., walk starts promptly at 9:00 a.m.

DISTANCES: 5 and 10 Km

DESCRIPTION: Named after a neighborhood in Manhattan, Murray Hill is a 1907 replat of the northern section of the Edgewood subdivision. In 1914, streetcar service was extended to the community and in 1915, Murray Hill was incorporated as its own town. Many early residents were railroad workers who built homes in Murray Hill due to its close proximity to the terminal in Lackawanna. Murray Hill was annexed to the City of Jacksonville in 1925. Primarily developed over the first half of the 20th century, Murray Hill is home to a diverse collection of architectural styles that combine to give the neighborhood a unique sense of place. Residential architectural styles include Bungalow, Craftsman, Prairie School, Colonial, Tudor Revival, Art Deco and Masonry Vernacular. Houses are typically smaller than those in other local historic districts. The oldest existing house in Murray Hill was built in 1898 at 916 Talbot Avenue.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: Water and restrooms are not available at the start point but are available along the route.

DIRECTIONS: On street parking is available around the park. Look for red shirts of our members in the park for registration table.
