**STIPULATIONS:** The fee for all walkers whether for AVA/IVV credit stamp or not is \$3. No refunds are provided after the start of the walk. The event takes place under all weather conditions unless deemed unsafe due to lightning or named storms requiring evacuation.

**PROCEDURE:** Arrive for the walk at 8:30 a.m. with the walk to begin at 9:00 a.m. The walk returns to the start and the completion time is 1 to 3 hours.

**PARTICIPATION:** This is a fun event for all persons. People of all ages are welcome to participate though an adult must sign for children under 18.

**REGISTRATION:** Register at the start and begin the walk.

**FOOD and WATER:** Water and restrooms are not available at the Start or along the route. In Florida it is suggested that you carry your own drinking water.

**SANCTIONED:** This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

## Old Ortega (Jacksonville, FL) Walk

**LOCATION:** Stockton Park; 4021 Ortega Blvd., Jacksonville, FL 32210

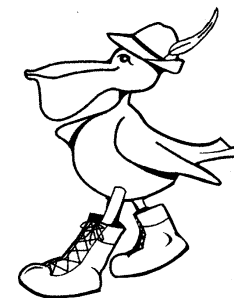
**START TIME:** 8:30 a.m. to register, 9:00 a.m. start walk

**DISTANCES:** 5 and 10 Km

**TRAIL RATING:** 1A

**AVA Special Prog:** Bridges – Spanning the USA, Points of Reference, Walk in a City Park

**DESCRIPTION:** Ortega is a historic neighborhood known for its giant oak trees, waterfront mansions, and parks. Ortega was platted and began development in the early 1900's. Most of Ortega's housing stock reflects the Mediterranean and Tudor Revival styles. Old Ortega was designated a U.S. Historic District on July 14, 2004 and contains 597 historic buildings.



**Water and restrooms are not available at the Start or along the route.**

**DIRECTIONS:** Directions: From U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Blvd), take Verona Avenue East (toward the St. Johns River). Turn left onto Ortega Blvd. Stockton Park is on the right. Note, if heading South on Roosevelt Blvd., pass San Juan Avenue and turn left onto Verona Avenue. If heading North on Roosevelt Blvd., pass Timuquana Road and turn right onto Verona Avenue.
